

BPE KENYA REPORT

The Bakhita Girls project is a non- profit project which provides access to secondary education for young mothers and under privileged girls in Kenya. In Kenya we have 16 schools assisting 320 vulnerable girls in 6Counties; Nairobi, Kiambu, Kajiado, Nakuru, Machakos and Murang'a.

We identify the neediest girls in the community aand provide back to school fees and other basic supplies required for them to attend classes. This project targets girls who come from disadvantaged socio economic status.

Since July 2022, Trainings for both principals and stakeholders have been facilitated so as to empower them with knowledge and skills. In the month of July 2022, 15 Administrators were trained on safe schools and safe environment and child friendly schools
